Dearest Virginia -

I just want to let you know that I am well ^{and} safe. I'm afraid you might have been worried by some of the claims of our enemy. God is still leading ^{and} His Will is enough for me.

I haven't received any mail since your letter of June 28th, so I have no way of knowing what has been happening there. Hope you are well ^{and} are keeping your faith that all will be well.

Who knows, I might get to see Lee before she's an old woman - haven't any idea what's going to come off - don't have any idea if or when I can mail this even. But I do want you to know that I am safe - ^{and} will be for some time to come. If I can get some of your letters I will feel better, ^{and} if I can mail this soon, I'll feel better yet.
